More Training Events at Conference on Today's Most Important Issues

More than 15 comprehensive educational programs that offer CEUs and LUs will be taught during the Council's Conference. A series of seminars examines major changes between the 2009 and 2006 codes, including the *International Energy Conservation Code*, which qualifies states for federal energy assistance grants when adopted and administered. Another session discusses the purpose, programs, and opportunities provided by the building energy provisions of the stimulus act, formally known as the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Also among the offerings are a discussion of the intent and organization of the *National Green Building Standard* (ICC-700), which was developed by the National Association of Homebuilders and the ICC, and a realistic case study to apply the standard.
